

TOP WOMEN SCOOPS ARCHITECTURAL AWARDS

The recent Corobrik-SAIA Awards of Excellence have honoured four women for their exceptional contributions to the architectural field. “These awards recognise the best of South African architecture,” said SAIA president, Sindile Ngonyama.

The Awards of Excellence were presented for eight projects and, in three of these projects the lead architects were from female practices or from those that have a woman as lead architect.

Charlotte Chamberlain and Nicola Irving, partners at Charlotte Chamberlain Architects in Cape Town, won their award for the new pre-school and art buildings at Springfield Convent School in Cape Town’s southern suburbs.

Michele Sandilands, principal of MSa Michelle Sandilands Architects in Cape Town, was honoured for her work on phase 2 of UNISA on the Cape Flats.

Anne Graupner of 26’10 south Architects received an Award of Merit for her studio home in Brixton, Gauteng.
